

OpenShot: The making of movies

- OpenShot is a movie making program.
- It lets you edit your movies and add cool audio and effects.
- You don't have to film your movies in order, you can piece them together in OpenShot.

How to use OpenShot.

- You have to save your movie to a folder, and then drag it into OpenShot. If it's a stop motion you have to pull all the pictures one by one into the bar where you will edit your movie.
- Lets say that you wonted to make a live action movie, you would film your scenes, and then drag them into OpenShot, and assemble them. It's easier than making a stop motion movie.

Making an animated movie

- To make an animated movie you have to start by drawing a frame.
- You have to draw a second frame. When your done with that, you save it and drag it into OpenShot. Than, arrange it so that it is in the right order. Add sound. And there you go!
- And don't get mad and eat the computer if you fail, I failed too, but I got it right. If that makes you feel better.
